Participation Options:

- ◆ Receive a four-part introductory *Field Trip to the Amazon* slide show featuring children from the Amazon villages that our adventure team will visit; with poetry and music. (For K-8 classroom, school assembly or presentation use.)
- ◆ Complete art and Email Q & A exchanges with K-12 classes in the Amazon.
- ◆ Receive curriculum-based PowerPoints and digital videos featuring K-12 students in the Amazon, w/ music and culture themes.
- ◆ Receive Google Earth Tours, *RARE (Rain Forest Activities & Resources) Emails* and *E-Travel Logs* from our adventure team before, as and after they visit the Amazon.
- ◆ Complete our *Amazin' Amazon Mystery Animal* poetry safari contest (& win authentic Amazon crafts!).

- ◆ Access the *Amazon River Elementary School Web site* and our online *Classroom Package* for teachers, w/ lesson ideas, reading materials, links & more.
- ◆ Complete a 1-on-1 videoconference Q & A with our adventure team leader.
- ◆ Support and follow our mural project at a schools in the Amazon region.
